Requirements:

Doctorate in biophysics, physics or chemistry, (habilitation for Poland-based candidates), documented expertise in physical methods of molecular research, including optical and resonance spectroscopies. Experience in studying interactions of metal ion with biomolecules and free radicals, with particular attention to mechanistic issues in neurodegenerative diseases. Candidates with additional experience in biochemical assays and cell culture studies are particularly welcome.

Description of position:

Initiation of an original line of research within the general scope of Department of Biophysics, support in current projects at the Department of Biophysics, supervision of students and junior staff.

Duration of contract: 12 months

Position: Professor (full-time)

Start of contract: 15.09.2018

Procedure:

Candidates are requested to submit the following documents (pdf):

- copy of Ph.D. award document
- CV with clause of permission for processing personal data according to GDPR (see below)
- motivation letter including brief description of previous employment
- two letters of reference
- list of scientific publications

The qualification of a successful candidate is a two-step procedure

1. Review of the applications and selection of candidates for the 2nd step by the Selection Committee. Only the selected candidates will be contacted.

2. Interviews with selected candidates including a short presentation of previous and proposed projects.

The decision will be made on the basis of the results of Step 2. All candidates will be informed about the result of the selection.
